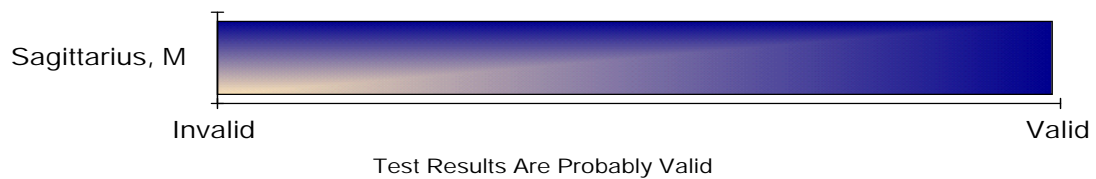

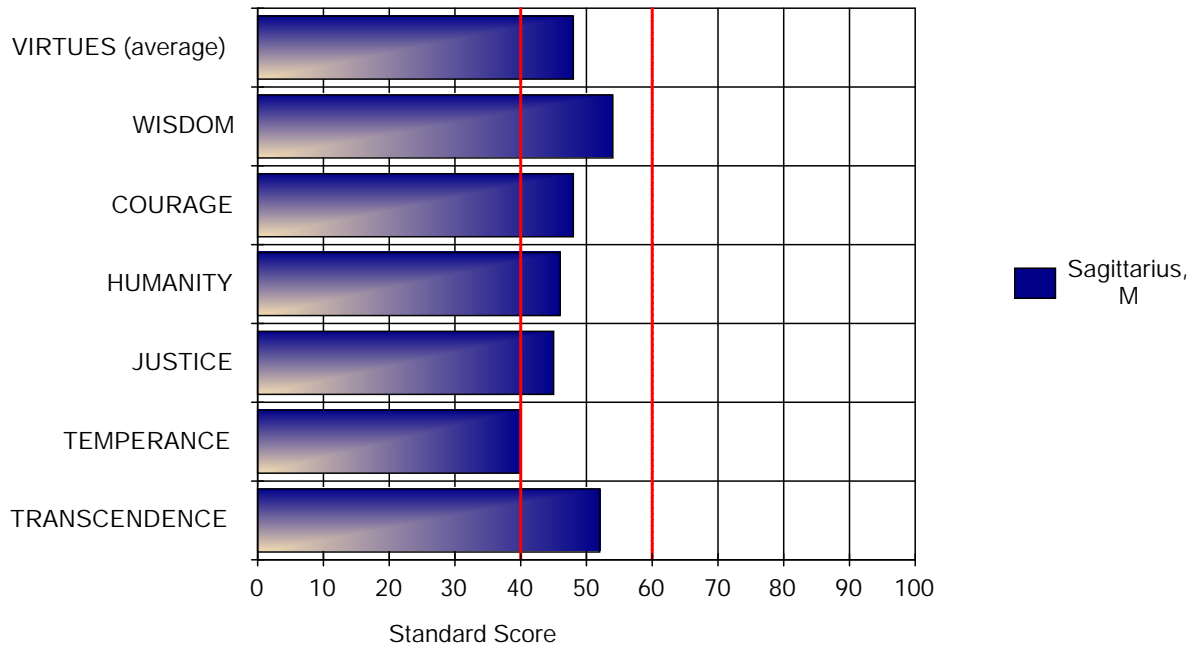

Introduction

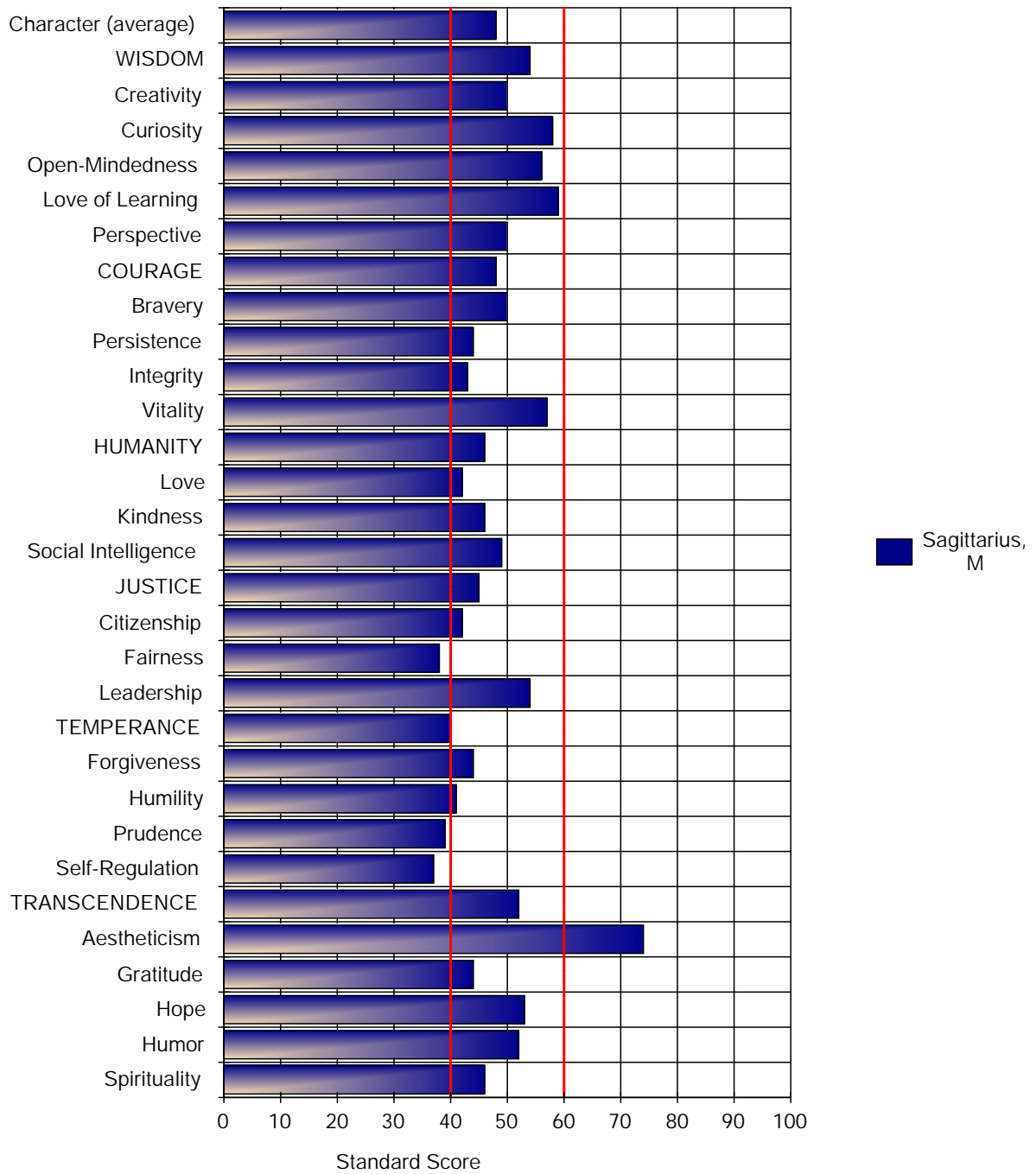

Justice
